Choose Life, Massachusetts Activities to Date

In May, I was interviewed as a guest on WEZE Christian radio by Lisa Haggerty regarding the Choose Life license plate.

On June 2<sup>nd</sup>, I appeared on Boston Catholic Television with Fr. Robert Reed. I was interviewed on his talk show, "This Is The Day." Afterwards, we taped a commercial for Choose Life. The commercial was played intermittently on BCTV.

On June 11<sup>th</sup>, I was invited to the home of Eleanor Rafferty to meet with representatives of the Priests For Life and speak about Choose Life.

On July 17<sup>th</sup>, I was interviewed on the radio show "In Season and Out of Season" with Fr. Tom DeLorenzo.

On August 12<sup>th</sup>, we hosted a table at the Proud2BCatholic festival in Framingham, MA.

On October 1<sup>st</sup>, we attended the Massachusetts Citizens for Life – Walk for Life where we hosted a booth.

I continue to be blessed with great kindness from so many people. My registration numbers are much lower than I had hoped. We started accepting registrations in May and to date, I have 300 people signed up. The reason is, I believe, that people take the application and just put it aside with the intent to send it in later. The problem is they never get around to it. I have heard this reason told to me sheepishly from more than one person.

I hope to do a mass mailing to all the Massachusetts Catholic Churches and Evangelical Churches before the end of the year. In preparation for this, I wrote to Cardinal O'Malley requesting his endorsement for the Choose Life license plate. The letter was sent in early October. I hope to do my mailing in December.

Lastly, I plan on hosting a table at the Boston Catholic Men's and Women's conference. There should be over 8,000 people in attendance. I will appeal to the organizers to help promote the license plate and hopefully put us over the top for registrations.
